The opportunity for independent study through structured case based problems discussed with a vet at the end of each week.

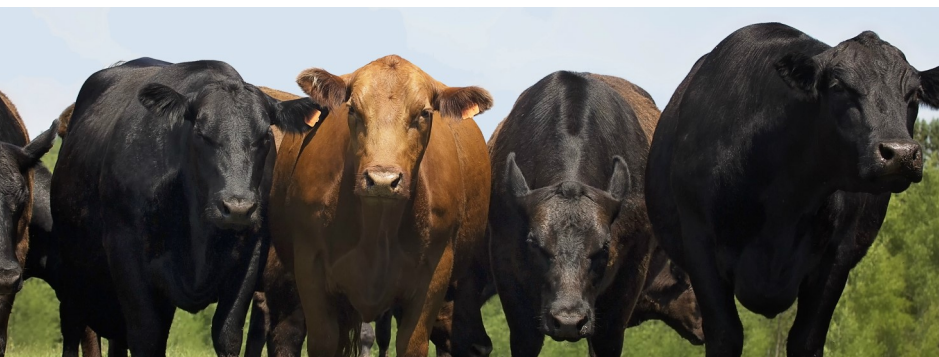
Electronic access to key beef and sheep papers to enable an evidence based approach to the case based problems. You can take these away with you.
